• Dazbog Coffee Co., an independent coffee company based in Denver, was named by History Colorado as the official coffee supplier for the new History Colorado Center, which opens April 28 at 1200 Broadway. In addition, Dazbog has agreed to support History Colorado's Annual Fund Campaign. Dazbog has a café in the new museum.

• Dynamic Funding Inc. (DFI), an Englewood-based equipment leasing company, completed equipment leases with the State of Colorado and Privia LLC, a technology solutions company based in Virginia. The operating lease with the state helped to facilitate a hardware upgrade. Privia's lease allowed the company to acquire both hardware and software assets to support the company's growth.

• ToolWatch Corp. of Denver will provide the software to track tools and equipment used to build the London Crossrail C-310 Thames Tunnel. The \$306 million contract is part of the \$22.5 billion project that will connect the east and west London rail routes. The project will use ToolWatch's Enterprise suite to track heavy equipment, machinery, vehicles and tools, as well as monitor equipment-servicing schedules and fuel consumption. The tunnel is scheduled to be completed in 2018. It is the largest construction project currently under way in Europe and the U.K.

• Solterra Senior Living, a Scottsdale, Ariz.-based company that operates and manages five senior-care communities in Colorado and Arizona, has acquired OHomeCare, an Englewood-based company that provides in-home care services for seniors. [Steve Jorgenson](#), president and chief executive officer of Solterra Senior Living, said that, effective immediately, the acquired company will be rebranded as Solterra at Home Services. Terms of the deal were not disclosed.
